### Recently Awarded Grants – 1<sup>st</sup> Grant Cycle 2017

**Assistance League of Pueblo** – Provide new school clothing to needy children referred by the local school districts. – **\$8,000**

**Bessemer Historical Society – Steelworks Center of the West**- Provide preservation of historic archives and artifacts of the Colorado Fuel and Iron Company and provide on-going education outreach to the community. – **\$20,000**

**Care and Share Food Bank** – Improve access to affordable nutritious foods by distributing food resources to pantries, emergency shelters, and other programs in Pueblo. – **\$50,000**

**CASA of Pueblo**- Provide court-appointed advocates for children who are before the court due to abuse and/or neglect cases. – **\$50,000**

**Early Learning Ventures** – Support Pueblo-based coaching staff to help build stronger business practices and higher quality child care services in Pueblo County. – **\$20,000**

**Mountain Park Environmental Association** – Support environmental education for children through the Earth Studies and Forest School for Little Rangers programs. – **\$50,000**

**Pueblo Child Advocacy Center**- Provide child abuse prevention, investigation, and victim support to children and their families. – **\$22,000**

**Pueblo Diversified Industries**- Provide support and services including employment for those with disabilities. – **\$30,000**

**Pueblo Symphony Association**- Provide music education and outreach for students in Pueblo's two school districts. – **\$15,000**
